## MIT making data visualization more accessible for blind and low-vision individuals



Researchers have created prototypes that enable screen-reader users to quickly and easily navigate through multiple levels of information in an online chart. An interdisciplinary team of researchers from MIT and elsewhere is striving to create screen-reader-friendly data visualizations that offer a similarly rich experience. They prototyped several visualization structures that provide text descriptions at varying levels of detail, enabling a screen-reader user to drill down from high-level data to more detailed information using just a few keystrokes.
