
PROBLEM STATEMENT

LEARNING

At AssisTech Foundation, we are committed to making education, knowledge availability and skill training more inclusive, especially for PwDs. We support Assistive Technology startups to meet the diverse learning needs of PwDs including accessible education apps for deaf children by **BleeTech**, and Virtual Reality tools for children with autism by **Halara**.

LIVELIHOOD

Our mission extends to helping PwDs achieve financial and social independence. We champion inclusive policies and connect Assistive Technology (AT) startups with our stakeholders to promote AT. Some innovations include motorised wheelchairs by **NeoMotion**, real-time and portable written-to-audio translators (Kibo) by **Trestle Labs**, and digital sign language translator by **Sonant Tech**.

LIVING

At AssisTech Foundation (ATF), we promote Assistive Technology to include essential aspects like healthcare, housing, transportation and equal rights, enabling PwDs to live independently. ATF works towards inclusivity, empowerment, and equality through supporting innovations like the bionic arm by **Symbionic** and the hands-free mouse for navigating desktops by **Dextroware**.

ATF AWARDS 2023

The ATF Awards 2023 celebrates stakeholders who anchor Assistive Technology (AT) to drive change. By hosting the Awards for the first time at the Bengaluru Tech Summit (BTS) 2023 as part of the AT Track, which we led, we were able to broaden the discourse on the Assistive Technology ecosystem.

ATHLETE UNLEASHED 5K RUN

AssisTech Foundation hosted the first AThlete Unleashed, an AT-driven segment in the WIPRO Bengaluru Marathon. The inspiring event, held on October 8th, 2023, witnessed 18 PwDs with their dedicated Buddy runners (CXOs & Industry leaders) crossing the finish line together in the 5-kilometre run.

I-INNOVATE

i-Innovate, a joint initiative of Reserve **Bank Innovation** Hub & HDFC Bank, with ATF, aimed at enabling financial inclusion for PwDs by leveraging Assistive Technology through an extensive

We have nurtured over 42 Assistive Technology (AT) startups through our Acceleration Programs along with a wider network of 450+ AT startups, that help bring innovative ideas to life and has resulted in 100+ product launches. AssisTech Foundation (ATF) empowers acceleration with various event touchpoints like the i-Innovate and cATalyst - our yearly Investor's Meet.

At ATF, we're working tirelessly to ensure that Assistive Technology is widely available. Through our curated digital marketplace—Adidvara, we are building a platform that brings assistive

solutions closer to PwDs by addressing the key barriers—affordability, infrastructure, and trained professionals.

Awareness breeds opportunity. We're proud to organise ATF Awards, India's first and only AT Awards, which celebrate unsung heroes of Assistive Technology - start-ups, partners, and enablers who make a meaningful difference. Another big campaign was the AThlete Unleashed 5k Run with PwDs, this year.

ASSOCIATION

Our global Inclusive Innovation Network (+N) and our Friends of ATF bring together leaders across industries and borders. This year, we facilitated panel discussions at the G20 Startup 20 Shikhar and established a presence at the Nasscom Global Inclusion Summit 2023. AssisTech Foundation also curated workshops collaborating with the Solve For Society Challenge, focusing on leveraging Assistive Technology.



TRENDS OF ASSISTIVE TECH

As Assistive Technology (AT) advances, our ability to promote inclusivity for PwDs will greatly improve. The global AT market for the disabled and elderly is expected to reach \$31.5 billion by 2027, while the disabled community, with a collective disposable income of \$8 trillion, stands as the world's third-largest economic power. This presents a very promising future.



END OF DISTANCE

AT is breaking down geographical barriers. Online platforms and apps enable remote support, connecting PwDs to therapists, educators, and peers. Telehealth services powered by AT bring healthcare to remote areas.

ATOMS MEET BITS

Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR) are revolutionising therapy for PwDs, offering immersive experiences that aid skill-building. From virtual therapy for physical rehabilitation to social interaction simulators. AR and VR have enabled better therapeutic experiences.





FROM ME TO WE

AT is reshaping social skill learning, enabling PwDs to practice communication, empathy and problemsolving in simulated social interactions. These technologies allow PwDs to learn from realworld scenarios in a controlled, supportive environment, fostering confidence.

NEW DIGITAL REALITY

Wearable technology is transforming the lives of PwDs. They can monitor vital signs, detect falls and assist with mobility. Sensory devices enhance sensory experiences while regulating devices manage conditions like epilepsy or anxiety. AT promotes independence and well-being.

FUTURE OF ATF DRIVING INNOVATION

ADVOCACY

With support from the Dept of Electronics Information Technology, Biotechnology, and Govt of Karnataka, ATF will establish a Center of Excellence for innovation with components like AT Experience Zone, Open Innovation Sphere & AT piloting.

GLOBAL COLLABORATION

ATF will partner with organisations worldwide to drive systemic change. We're now a global network with six countries (India, Australia, New Zealand, Kenya, Canada, and Hong Kong). ATF plans to expand this alliance to 15+ countries. Moreover, ATF will launch a Global Acceleration Program.



FUNDING INNOVATION

ATF will develop funding streams like grants and venture capital to support startups and innovators creating next-generation AT solutions. The focus will be on two key areas—AI for Disability and AT for Neurodiversity and Neurodevelopment.




